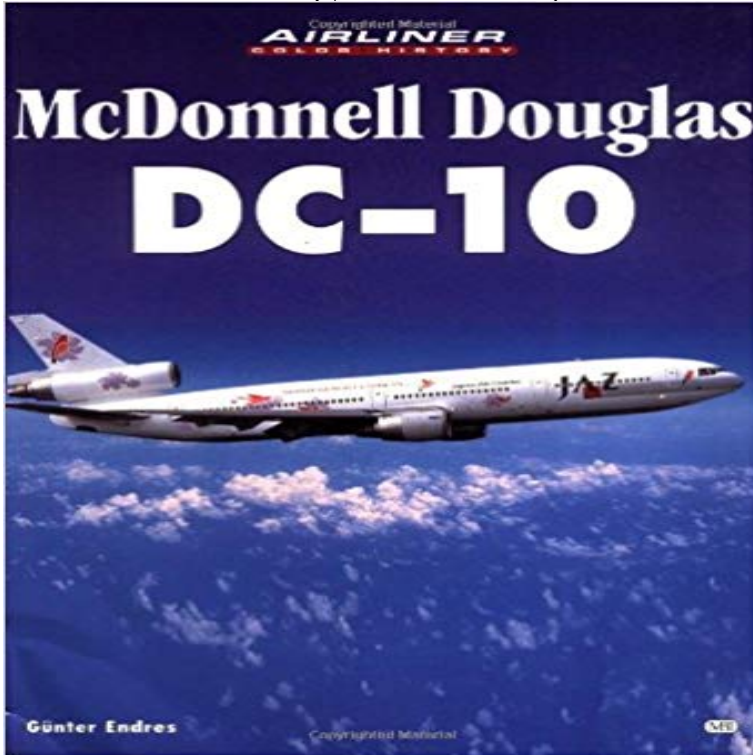


McDonnell Douglas DC-10 (Airliner Color History)
