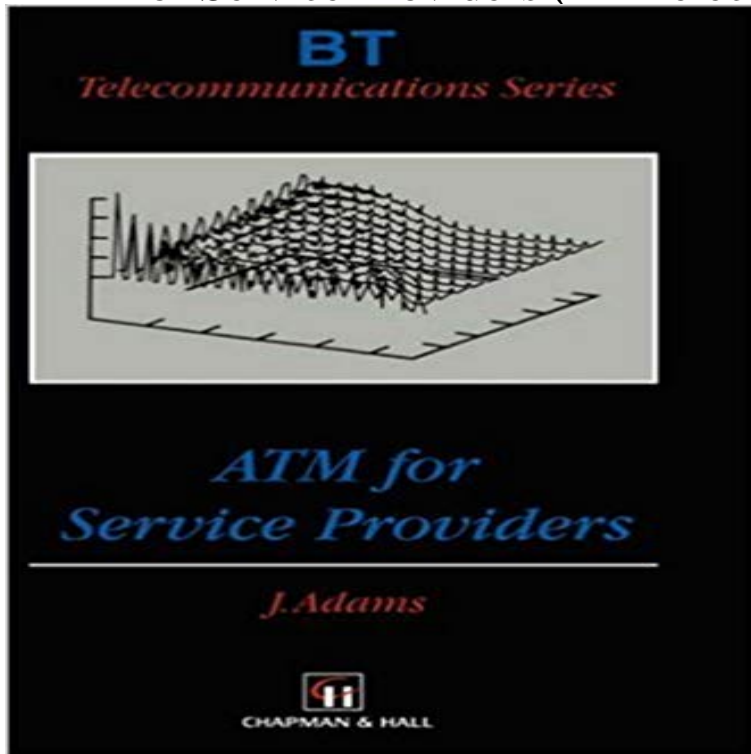


ATM for Service Providers (BT Telecommunications Series)
