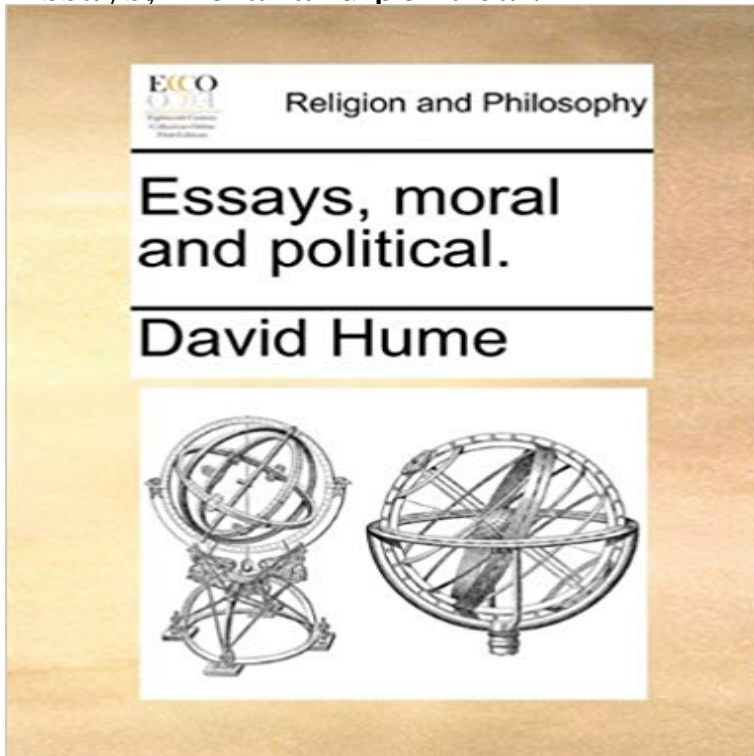


## Essays, moral and political.
