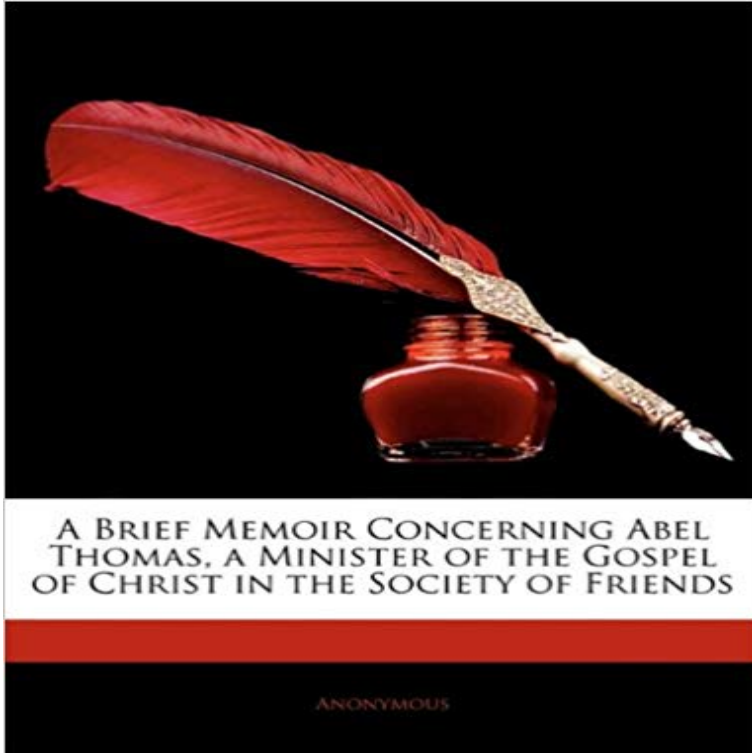


A Brief Memoir Concerning Abel Thomas, a Minister of the Gospel of Christ in the Society of Friends
