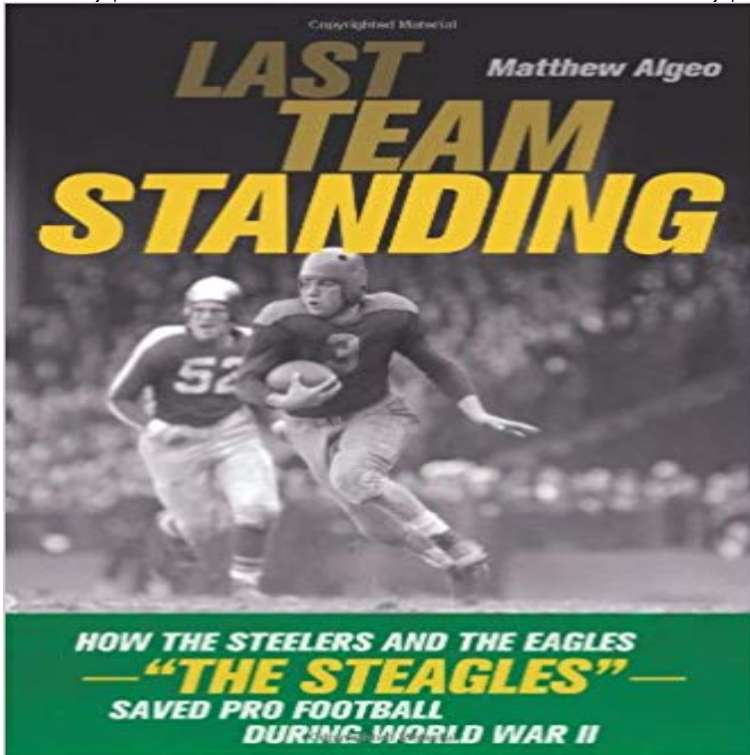


Last Team Standing: How the Steelers and the Eagles—The Steagles—Saved Pro Football During World War II
