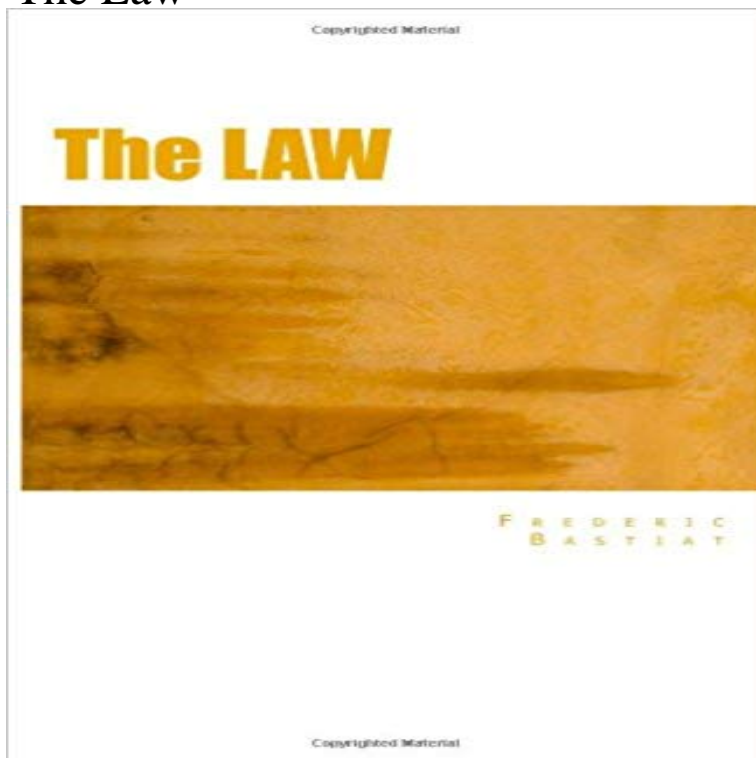


# The Law
