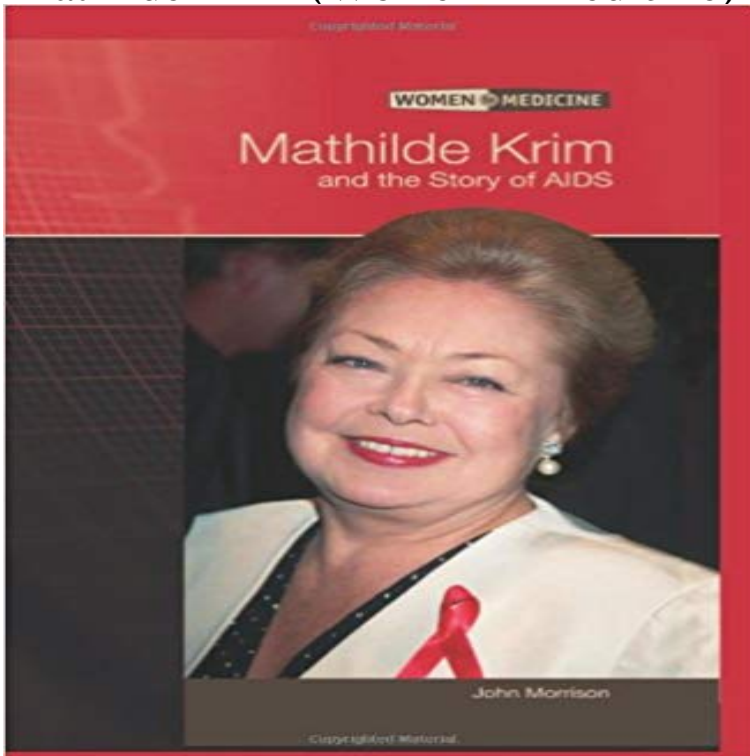


Mathilde Krim (Women in Medicine)
