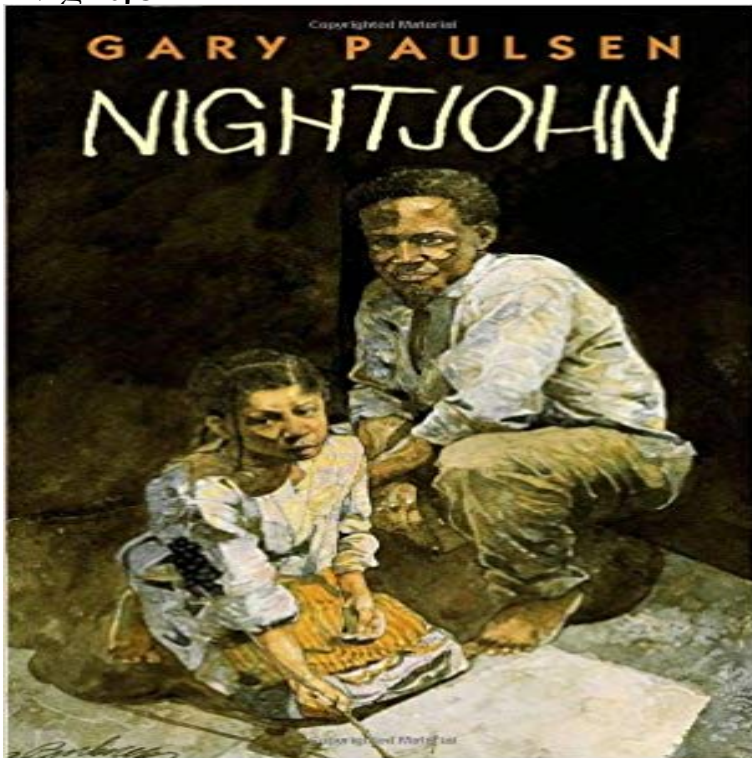


Nightjohn
