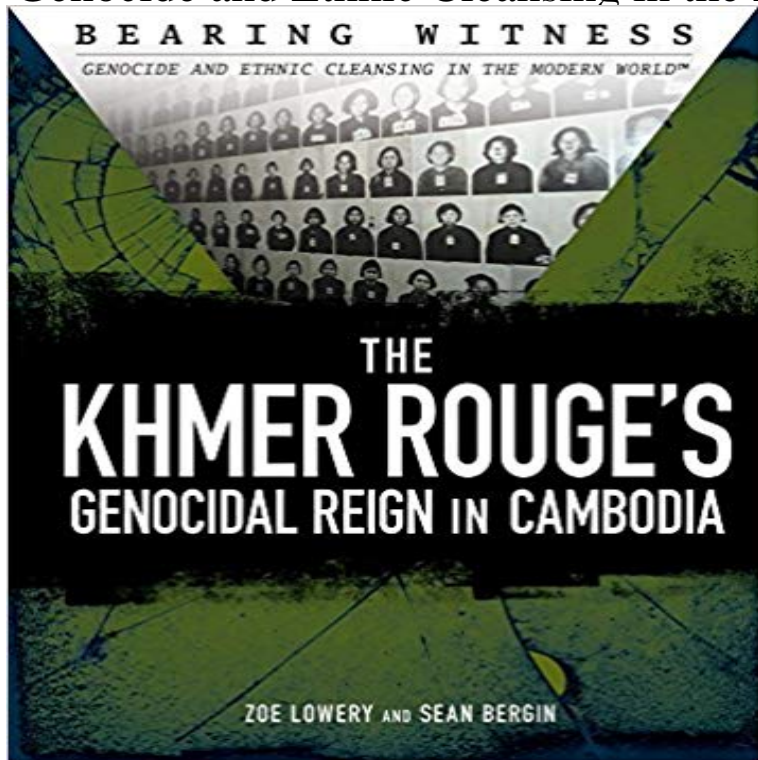


The Khmer Rouges Genocidal Reign in Cambodia (Bearing Witness: Genocide and Ethnic Cleansing in the Modern World)
