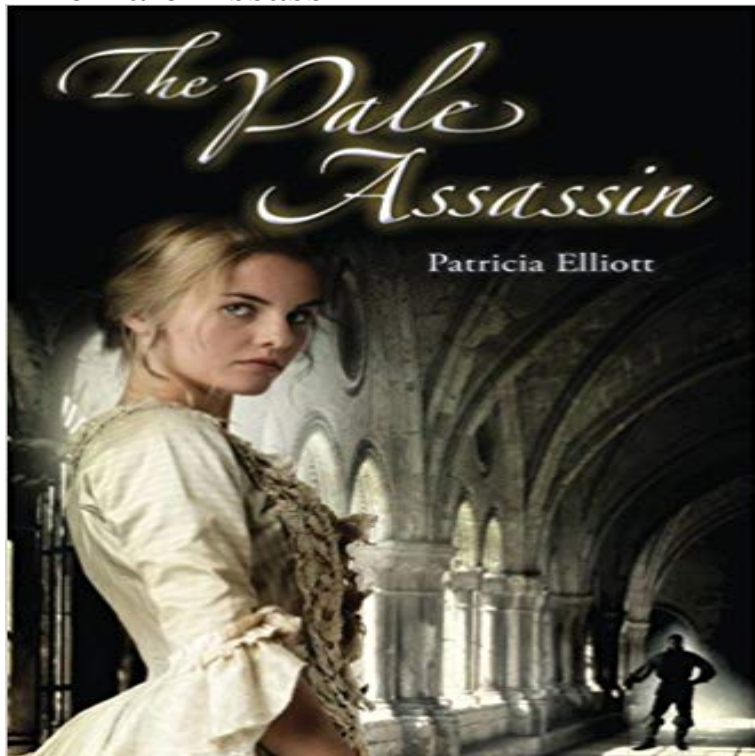


The Pale Assassin
