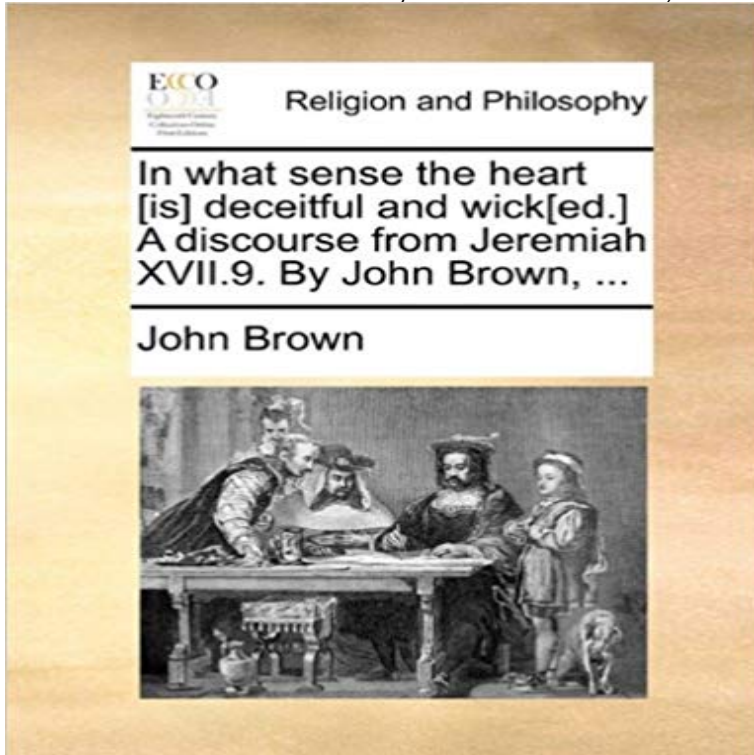


# In what sense the heart [is] deceitful and wick[ed.] A discourse from Jeremiah XVII.9. By John Brown, ...
