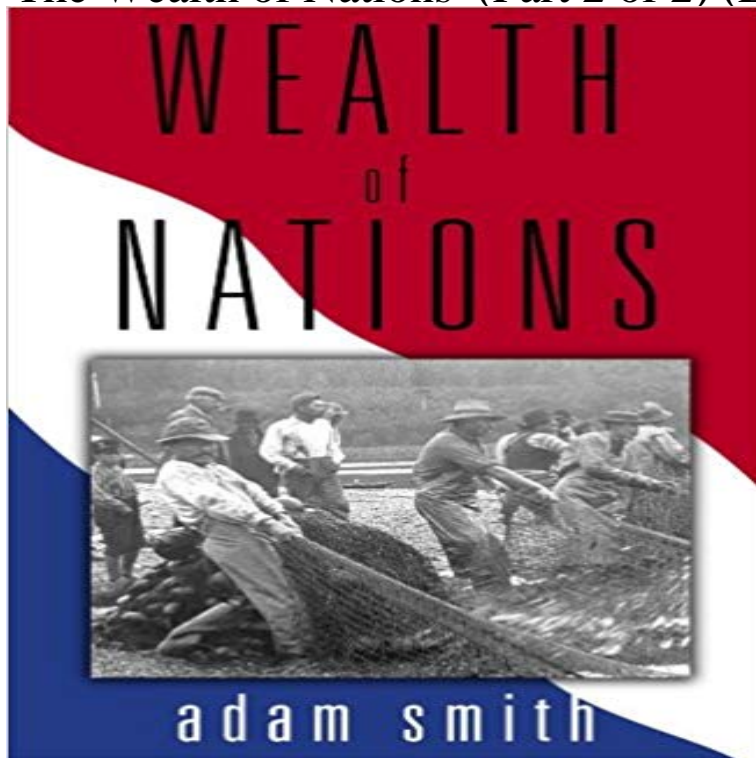


The Wealth of Nations (Part 2 of 2) (Library Edition)

Several fundamental principles or axioms were introduced in this work, including the division of labor, supply-and-demand, and free market capitalism as some of the most obvious. Smiths political economy is primarily individualistic: self-interest is the incentive for economic action. However, he shows that universal pursuit of self-interest contributes to the public interest, a concept probably best encapsulated by John F. Kennedy when he remarked, a rising tide raises all boats.
