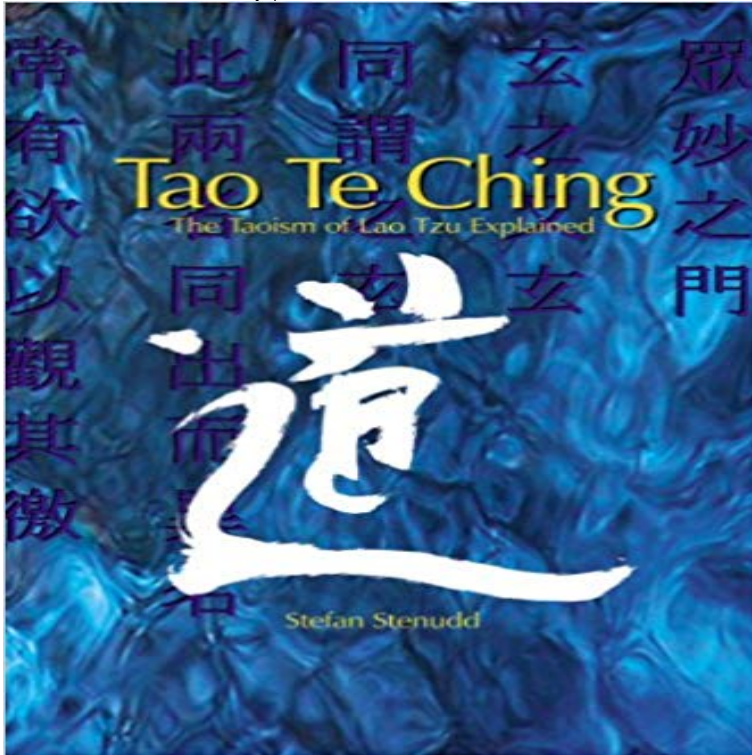


Tao Te Ching: The Taoism of Lao Tzu Explained
