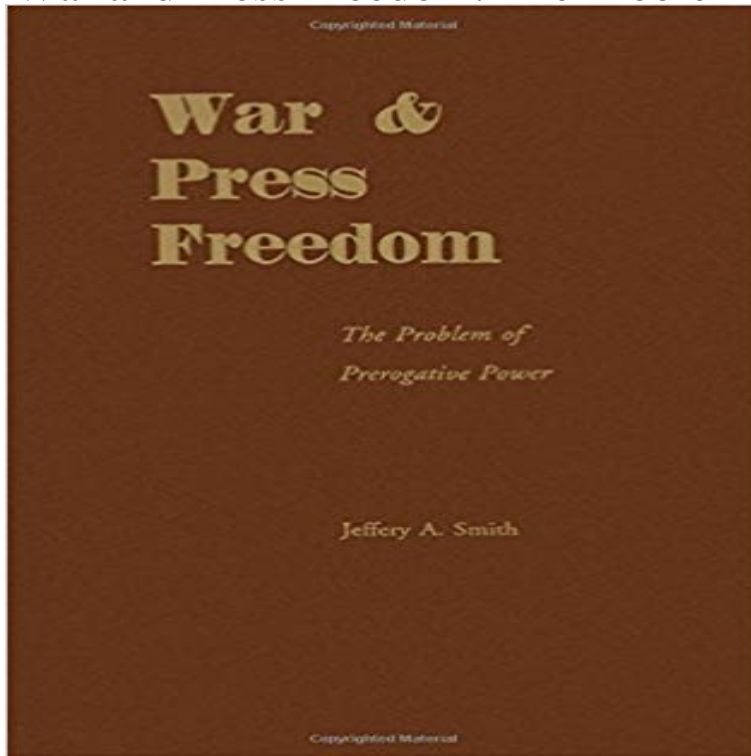


War and Press Freedom: The Problem of Prerogative Power

When restrictions were challenged as violations of the Constitution, military regulations and federal laws were justified as necessary under the higher law of survival. Is there law more important than the Constitution which allows prerogative powers to be used in a time of war or national crisis?
